- Regional private non-profit agency founded in 1996 with programmes designed with the ultimate goal to support research and innovation in Centre-Val de Loire region (Orléans, Tours, Blois, Bourges, Chartres...) in all thematic disciplines;
 - Born with the original vision that internationalization of research would benefit to the scientific community in general;
 - Mission of LE STUDIUM is to:
 - Strengthen the international visibility of regional research
 - Support international collaborative research projects relying on the mobility of experienced international researchers across all scientific disciplines
 - Contribute to the development and attractiveness of the territory
- => **unique structure in France with a large spectrum and original formats, a space for intellectual and scientific exchanges**



- Membership – 45 members from the higher education institutions, Research Centres, Business, Personalities
- International Scientific Council of 25 members
- Operational Team of 5 members
- Resources and Budget – Region, local authorities, partners, European Union (COFUND, ERDF) – 3 M€/year
- 40 Fellows welcomed per year
- Organisation of 60 international events/year
- Collaboration with more than 30 different laboratories/year
- Dedicated spaces: Hôtel Dupanloup and Château de La Motte Sanguin in Orléans, partnership with universities in Orléans, Chartres, Blois, Bourges and Tours



- Attraction and selection of senior international experienced scientists through peer evaluations and scientific council
- Fellowships of long duration offering time to develop research projects and establish sustainable collaborations.
- Quality environment (furnished housing, administrative assistance, career development support...)
- A complete scientific environment with opportunities and funding to organise events (international scientific conferences, workshops, general public conferences, interdisciplinary seminars, international scientific networking actions ...)

International development

Constitution of an international network: Workshop + 1 day meeting

- Invitation of 4 or 5 international colleagues during 2 days
- Small workshop on the first day in order to let everyone present his/her background & expertise
- Work meeting on the second day in order to discuss a future collaborative strategy including international proposal (H2020, Eureka)

=> **Role of Le Studium:** coordination of the event, logistics (venue, travel, hotel, etc.), mobilisation of needed experts (H2020 projects, Intellectual property, etc.)

- When an international consortium has been built and a call for proposals identified
- 5-day meeting gathering the partners of the future project in order to define and write the answer to the call for proposals
- Opportunity to invite some collaborators and/or industrials for limited time
- Possibility to organise videoconference exchanges with international experts

=> **Role of Le Studium:** coordination of the week meeting, logistics (venue, travel, hotel, etc.), mobilisation of needed experts (CMER for example)

- Objective to invite an internationally recognized colleague on a very specific subject and organize a series of meetings
- One to two week(s) visit
- Visit of academic laboratories and companies
- Opportunity to give presentations to several audiences (academics, industrials, students, politics, etc.)

=> **Role of Le Studium:** coordination of the Experts Days event, logistics (venue, travel, hotel, etc.), communication

- Organisation of a 3-day workshop on a specific topic
- Between 40 and 80 participants
- 10 invited speakers & 10 registered speakers
- Objective to meet new scientists and to consolidate scientific collaborations
- Opportunity to highlight the local expertise

=> **Role of Le Studium:** organisation of the conference, logistics (venue, travel, hotel, etc.), communication, preparation of the materials for the event (booklet of abstracts for example)

Welcoming an international delegation

- Opportunity to welcome a scientific delegation from abroad in order to highlight the local expertise
- Identification of mutual interests to establish collaborative scientific projects
- Workshop with mutual presentations time and funding opportunities review
- Face to face targeted meetings with local research units

=> **Role of Le Studium:** Interactions with the delegation, logistics (venue, travel, hotel, etc.), communication, mobilisation of local partners
